Headlines

- Exceptional overall achievement demonstrated by indicative value-added score of +0.90
- 93% achieve a standard pass in GCSE English, 91% a standard pass in GCSE mathematics
- 90% of students achieved 'standard' GCSE passes at grade 4 or above in both English and mathematics.
- 68% of students achieved the 'strong pass' threshold achieving grade 5 and above in both English and mathematics. 82% achieved a strong pass in English and 73% in mathematics
- Exceptionally strong attainment across the EBacc 'pillars' by all students resulting in an EBacc average point score of 5.42
- 32% of the GCSE cohort achieved 5 or more 9-7 grades and 73% achieved 5 or more grades 9-5 Almost every subject achieved above 80%+ 9-4 at GCSE
- The school's indicative Attainment 8 score is 58.20 points, which means students achieved an average of grade 6 (B) in their subjects
- A level results were extremely strong for the school with A*-B, 52% A*-C at 86%, and 99% A*-E.

Year 11 - Key Stage 4 Progress

Sixth Form Attainment

The vast majority of students in the Bennett Sixth Form (80%) take a full suite of at least three A level courses. At A level results were again very strong at each of the main thresholds, with 52% of entries achieving A*-B, 83% achieving A*-C and 99% A*-E. 80% of students achieved at least 3 A levels at A*-E, and 82% 2 A levels A*-E in a context where the remaining 41 students were all highly successful in completing a two A level equivalent Cambridge Technical Diploma, the majority at the Double Distinction level.

The average points score per A level entry was 36.01 points per entry, a B- grade on average. Average grades by qualification type are shown below
