

Does your child have any of the symptoms identified by the NHS relating to COVID 19

Your child should attend school

Inform the school. Your child should continue to isolate for 10 days from the first sign of symptoms. The rest of your household should continue to isolate for 14 days. Remote teaching will be provided

You must not send your child to school.

You should get your child tested and isolate for 10 days from the first sign of symptoms. Report the absence to attendance@bennett.kent.sch.uk The rest of your household, including siblings, must isolate for 14 days. They do not require a test unless they display symptoms. Remote teaching will be provided which they should access if they are well enough to do so.
